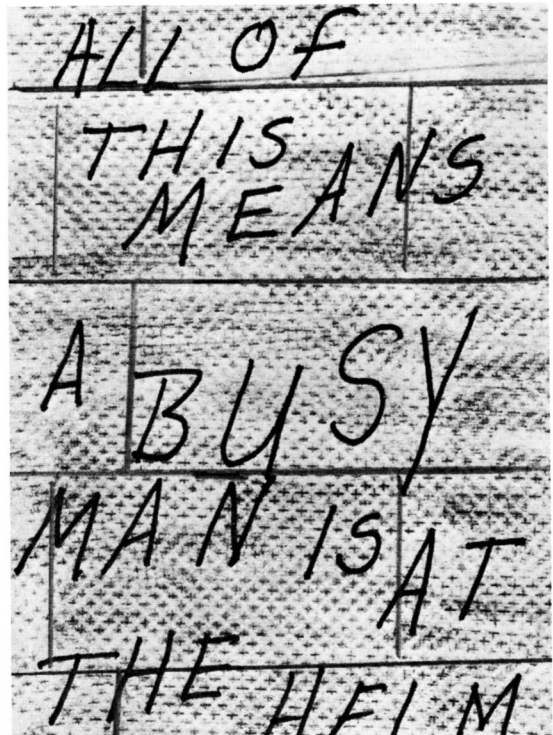
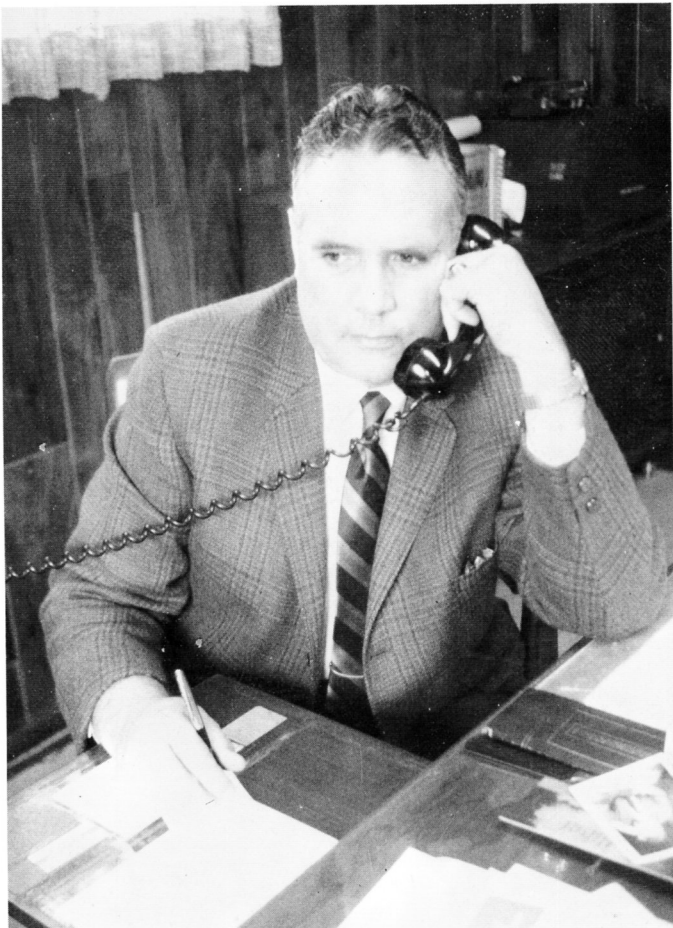
The philosophy of the Hughes School includes a belief in a well-rounded individual. For this reason during the 1971-72 year we note the following

- additional breakdown of classes into smaller groups

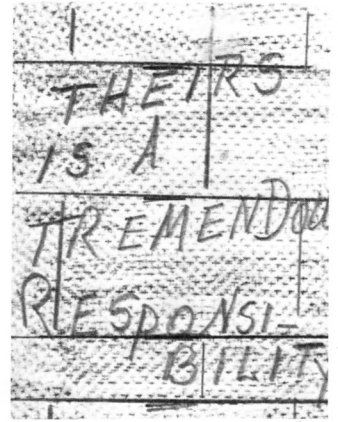
