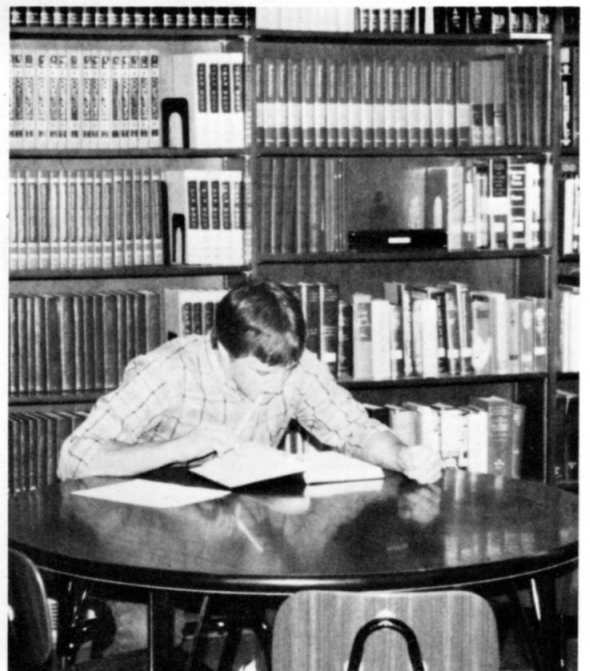
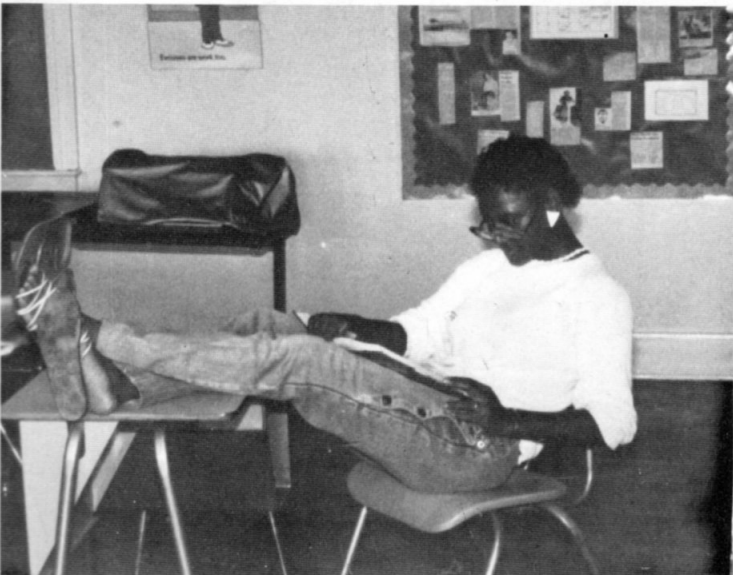
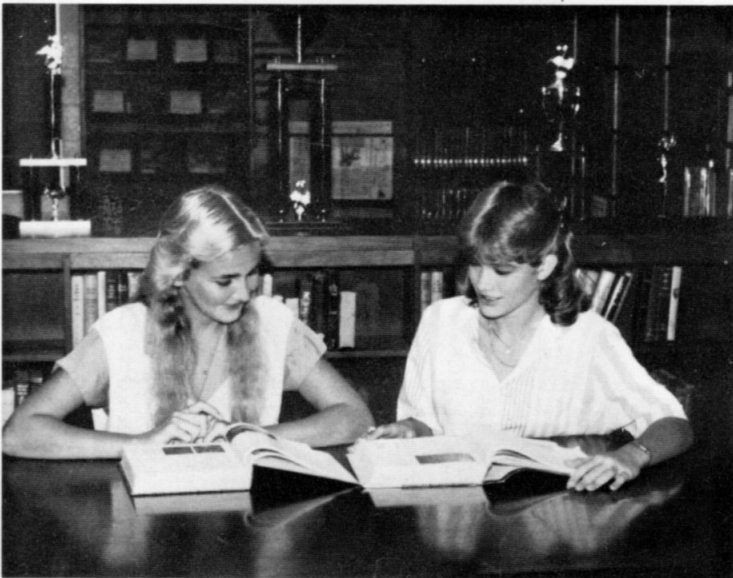
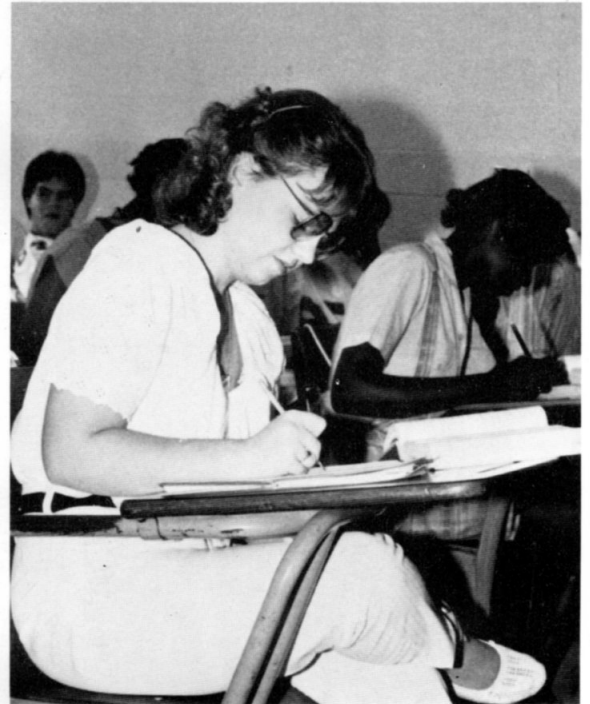
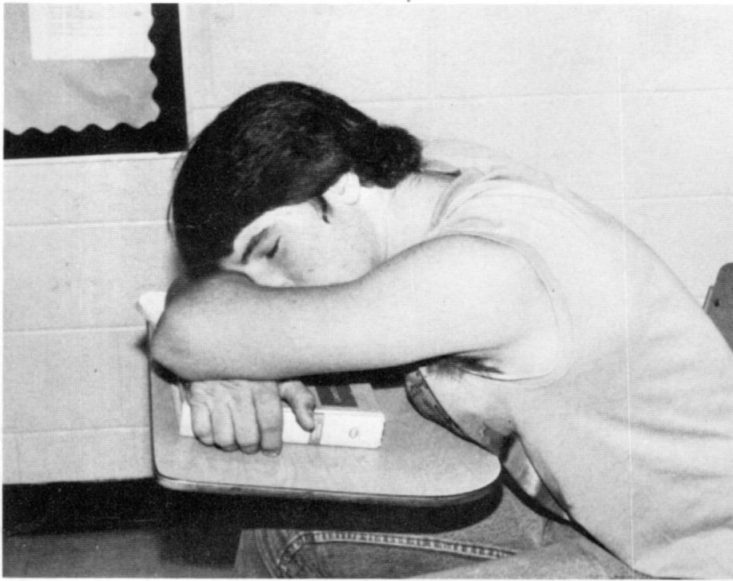
Look at how we play.

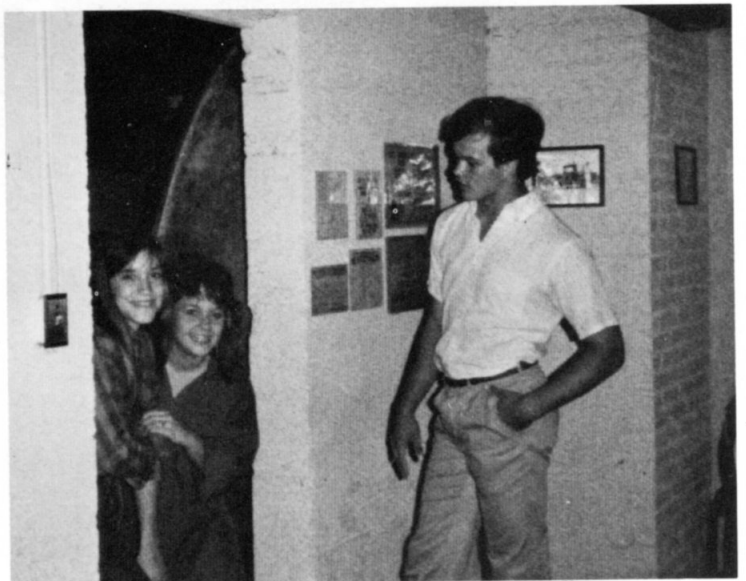
Look at how we study . . .

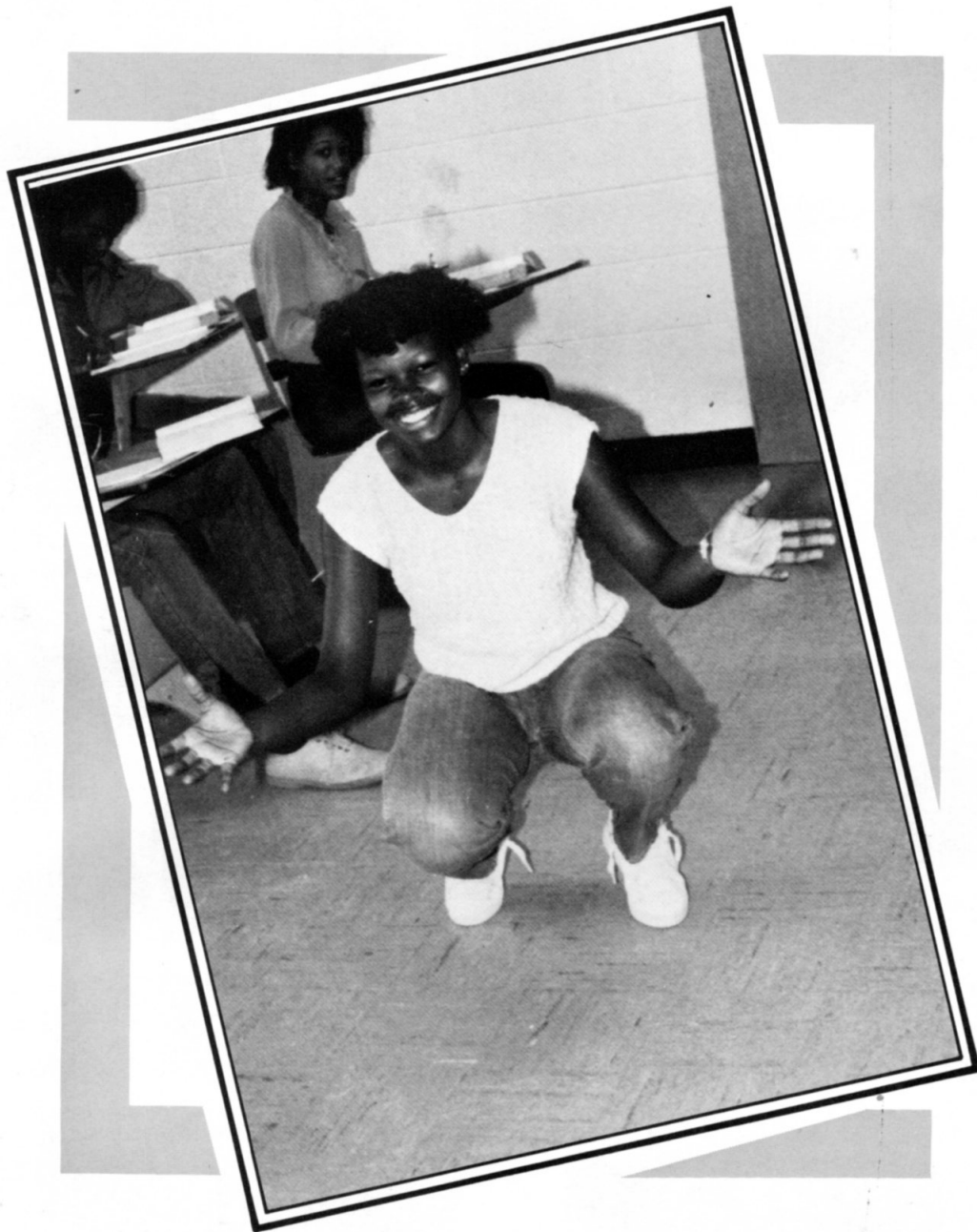


Look at How We Dress . . .

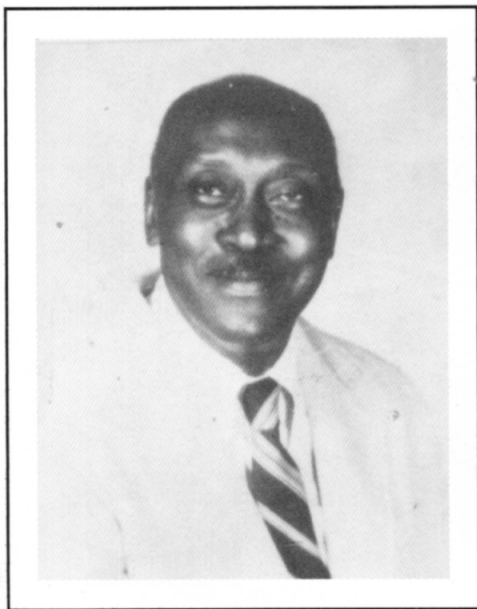
A Look at the Elementary Administration

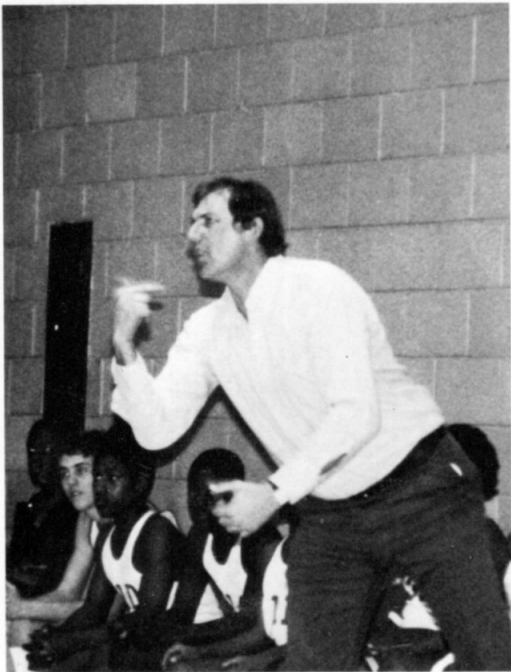

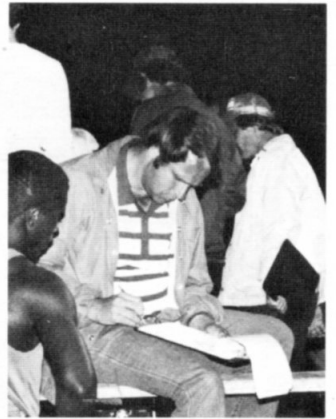


Track
